



Checklist for Donations of Healthcare Items

As a healthcare facility, supplies
must meet the following criteria to be accepted as donations:

- The items are **not expired** or near the expiration date.
- The items are **less than 1 year old**.
- The items **have not been opened or used**.
- The items are **clean**—free of dust, cobwebs, odor, etc.

If the item meets the general guidelines outlined above,
these are the types of donations accepted:

NITRILE Exam Gloves (all sizes — NO LATEX)

Some Medications (must still have manufacturer seal)

Hygiene Items

(shampoo, soap, toothbrushes & toothpaste—unexpired, unopened, unused)

We do not accept donations of orthopedic items, medical equipment
(such as wheelchairs, crutches, wound vacs...), narcotics of any kind,
scheduled drugs, catheters, IV fluids & supplies, etc.

Other Options

No local healthcare facilities will be able to use expired medications or supplies. However, please follow community guidelines for disposing of them properly.

Expired /Unused Medications

- Please take them to the Kennewick, Pasco or Richland **police department**.
- The police departments also have “Drug Take Back Days” twice each year—in April and October.

Unused Needles / Sharps

- Please contact the **waste disposal company** that serves your neighborhood. They will instruct you on proper disposal.

Other Supplies (not medications or sharps)

- You may be able to throw away gauze, bandages and other supplies if they are not usable. Please check with your **waste disposal company** if you have questions.
